Before December 2008,

Kayla was a happy & healthy 3 1/2 year old.

She loved to dance, read, sing & play.

Then, without warning, life changed drastically for Kayla and the Musto family when she was diagnosed with OMS.

OMS...Opsoclonus-Myoclonus Syndrome is a neurological disorder in which the body's immune system over-reacts & attacks the brain.

This disorder is so rare, it affects only

1 in 10,000,000.

OMS is not curable and will require aggressive medical treatment,

in addition to ongoing physical, occupational and speech therapy for Kayla.
